We are so excited to meet our little baby. Please keep us in your prayers specifically for extra strength for Elsa and a healthy womb.

A few things ahead of us,

We plan to give birth in the States, which means we will be back much sooner than we originally anticipated. After a long process, we were able to find and schedule an appointment to see a doctor in Ethiopia. Everything is going well and the baby is growing. We learn that the cut off date for Elsa to travel is at seven months pregnant. For this reason, we're planning to be back in the first week of June.

Though we know God will provide all of our needs as parents we also believe God uses our hands and feet so we can walk this life together. Therefore, we want to be open and transparent with all of our needs so we can all pray together.

1. Immediate Needs:

• I have to have a job as soon as we get back to the Sates that provides medical insurance for Elsa and my self. Because Elsa is not a US citizen, she is not covered with any medical insurance. Please, let us know of any jobs openings that you know of. I will be available to start working at the

- beginning of June.
- Another immediate need is housing in the States. It is a concern that we have as we bring a baby into this world. We do not want to burden anyone, but would like to ask if you know of any house available for six months or so, please let us know. Another option is renting a one-bedroom apartment for six months while we are in the States. If you know of anyone renting a cheap apartment please keep us in your mind.



Soccer Ministry and Ankle Injury.

My passion to work with street youth using soccer as a tool has taken me into an adventure. Since our last update, I went out to play soccer and twisted my ankle really badly. It slowed me down and I was on crutches for two and half weeks. I still cannot

do certain movements but I am able to walk on it. I have not been able to play soccer and I miss it. I want to get back out there and slowly get to know the kids. When this happen we felt like God was telling us to slow down.

Language School Praise Report.

Some of you specifically prayed that God would give me the ability to learn the language fast, "it will be fun and it will be easy for you to learn." This was the prayer I received and wow, it has been fun and it has been easy. I am learning the way a baby learns. No translation is done, I observe pictures and I listen, then I learn the word. What usually takes 6 weeks to complete the first phase of language learning I will have completed in 3 weeks this Friday! Praise God! I will able to start phase 2 next week!
